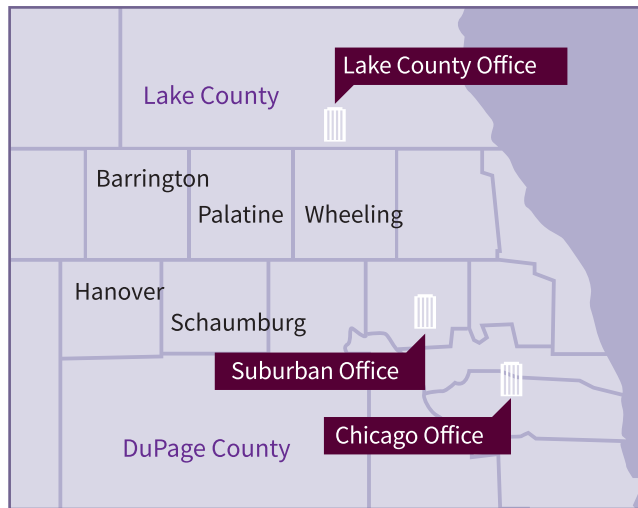

What is Home Care Service?

Home care Service provided by homecare aides allows frail older adults with special needs to obtain physical and psychological well-being in their own home by keeping them out of a long-term care facility.

Types of Home Care Service

<p>CCP Home Care Service</p> <p>Community Care Program (CCP) supported by the Illinois Department on Aging established in-home assistance for older adults to improve their quality of life by cherishing their dignity and independence. As a CCP contracted agency, Hanul provides trainings to home care aides to be sent to eligible seniors.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 60 and older resident of Illinois • US Citizens or Green Card Holders • Have non-exempt assets less than \$17,500 for 1 person household (\$35,000 for 2 people household) • Physically challenged in performing household tasks 	<p>Must be assessed by the local Care Coordination Unit (CCU) in your area to determine types and frequencies of your services.</p>
<p>Private Home Care Service</p> <p>Administered by the Illinois Department of Public Health, Hanul holds private home care license to provide in-home assistance to people who do not meet the eligibility guidelines for the CCP home care service.</p>	<p>Regardless of age, legal status, income level, anyone who is in need of services are welcome to apply.</p>	<p>After the initial assessment conducted by Hanul Private Home Care Program staff, service agreement is established between Hanul and client.</p>

Established in 1989, Hanul Family Alliance (formerly known as Korean American Senior Center) was the very first Korean ethnic service provider that was approved of CCP contract with the Illinois Department on Aging.
