



REIMAGINING COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

Thanks to our partnerships, many of Hanul's direct services have expanded into new initiatives, some of which include:

- **Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) renewals:** Our Immigration & Legal team began offering DACA renewals and outreach.
- **Project Youth Connection (PYC):** A new initiative that built a peer-led survey to help inform future programming and volunteer opportunities.
- **Free legal clinic with Mirae Law:** Each month over the past year, Mirae Law has been visiting Hanul's clients to provide free legal consultation.
- **Return to in-person classes:** After more than two years, English classes are returning to Hanul offices and local libraries.

REIMAGINING MENTAL WELLNESS

CLIENT STORY:

Jae Myung Lee provided individual counseling and psychiatric services to a client dealing with a mental health crisis. The client was initially referred to Hanul by his parents. After struggling for the first few months, his symptoms gradually reduced over the year. This spring, he got a full-time job and has been doing well at work and home.

HOW TO CHECK FOR MENTAL WELLNESS WITH HANUL:

STEP 1: Prevention

- Screening / Assessment
- Mental health seminars and resources

STEP 2: Early Intervention

- Review screening / assessment result
- Individual consultation
- Formulated plan based on client's goals

STEP 3: Active Care

- Individual / couple / family counseling
- Support groups and psychoeducation

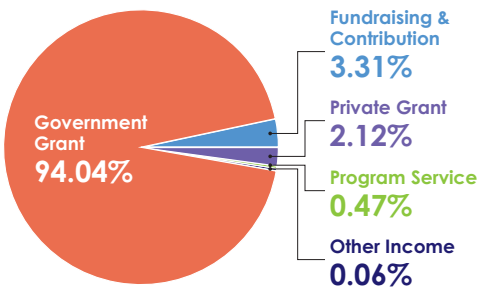
